Bay Pride has three vendor options: Food Vendor, Non-Profit or Retail Vendor.

Each vendor space is 10×10. Please purchase an additional booth if you need additional space.

If your booth requires electricity please note on the application when describing what you plan to sell or promote.

Canopies and other accessories are not provided.

VENDOR RULES & REGULATIONS:

Bay Pride is a RAIN OR SHINE event. There is no RAIN DATE.

Vendor Booth Prices:

\$40.00 Retail / Business Table

\$100.00 Food Truck

\$00.00 Non-Profit or Government Agency

- 1. Vendors can start to check in at 8:00 am on Saturday, June 6, 2020.**
- 2. All Vendors must be checked in and setup by 10:00 am June 6, 2020.**
- 3. Vendors will be instructed where to enter the Festival grounds upon arrival at Aaron Bessant Park.**
- 4. Upon arriving at the Festival all vendors need to check-in at the CENTER Booth just inside the main entrance.**
- 5. Setup and tearing down is the responsibility of the vendor.**
- 6. There will be no reserved parking for vendors.**
- 7. No weapons are permitted at the Bay Pride Festival.**

8. Vendors may have private beverages and food containers in their booths for their use only. You may not sell food or beverages unless you have a food vendors license.
9. Vendors are required to stay through the Festival hours of 12 pm to 9 pm.
10. Vendors are responsible for the security of their materials at all times.
11. Neither members of the LGBTQ Center of Bay County Inc. Board of Directors nor members or volunteers of the Bay Pride Festival are responsible for any lost or stolen items, and/or any harm or injury sustained to themselves or their person(s) resulting from theft, fire, water accident or any other cause.
12. Vendors can distribute FREE bottled water.
13. If a Vendor encounter's protestors, report it immediately to the PRIDE Booth at the main entrance.
14. Bay Pride Festival / LGBTQ Center of Bay County will provide security per local regulations.
15. No Refunds. Fees considered a donation to Bay Pride Festival.
16. Vendors will be required to anchor tents with weights and should avoid stakes if possible.
